The Industrial Board has the opportunity to say this is what success looks like. ITEP is 3 months from creating the pilot to get it up and running and we've already not a plan. Problem is getting ITEP through Police Jury, School Board and Sheriff for Equilibrium Catalyst. an will be here Wednesday, April 17 for the police jury meeting. Ronnie and Mike and any other EDC board members are welcome to meet with Van prior to the meeting. We need people there to stand up and speak up at the police jury.
