CEO/President report, Marion Fox

- Bob Patrick with Habetz Construction came out and made the outline for the new building.
 We are still waiting for the ground to dry up, so we can finish the dirt work.
- Louisiana Office of Tourism has a new branding for the state. Instead of "Pick your Passion" its "Louisiana Feed your Soul"
- Louisiana legislative session dealing with taxes and how to close the gap in the budget. The enterprise funds will probably not come up this year.

Marketing Director Report: Dione Sabelhaus

- Louisiana 2016 tax revenues were reported as following, 46.7 million visitors to Louisiana and they spent \$16.8 billion and as a result generated \$1.04 billion in state tax revenues.
- I will attend the TravelSouth Domestic Show in Biloxi MS on March 18 21. I will meet with 48 tour operators and media writers.
- We have a Fam media tour from TravelSouth that will tour Bayou Rum on March 21. On the same day Trips Unlimited will tour the Gator Chateau and Bayou Rum, this motorcycle group comes out of San Antonio. We have a huge tour series coming into our

- area with over 30 dates starting in April and ending in March 2019. This group of young tourist fly into New Orleans or Houston.
- Crawfish tours are starting up next week and as of now we have 16 schools and 3 bus tour groups.

 Commission to conduct business on behalf of Jefferson Davis Parish Tourist
 Commission for said cards.
- A motion was made by Ryan Kitchen, seconded by Bobby Palermo, to approve \$1,000.00 for the Squeeze Box Shootout grant and passed unanimously. Jennings Festival Association spent \$1,000 on promoting the event so the board agreed to match the \$1,000.
