<u>Old Business</u>: Chairman Ronnie Petree the Search Committee Update. Stating that 11 applications were received and reviewed. All applicants are qualified and with great skills to offer. Any of these 5 would be great fits for the position. Chairman Petree extended added thanks and acknowledgement to all the staff of the 3 entities for their efforts getting through this time of transition.



Chairman Ronnie Petree updated conversations on name change potential for Flyways and Byways. We are looking into the exact cost of the signs which are created by the DOTD. We ran just shy of presenting this legislation for now, but will continue diligent to see it through for next year.

Chairman Petree gave a reminder to all Board members to complete and file Financial Disclosure Statements and send a copy to the ED Office for record keeping and filing.

New Business: Angel Scott, on behalf of Imperial Calcasieu and their representative, Mayor Henry Guinn presented details of the Grant Opportunity Pilot Program through Imperial Calcasieu and its efforts to bring Lafayette Utility System into the City of Jennings. This grant is target to offer and secure fiber services to our area. The current route for the grant request will head south from I10 down to Hwy 90 and then West to the end of the city limits. It also has a route to move east covering the area of the City of Jennings Administrative Buildings. In this conversation, Interim Director Greg Marcantel mentioned the desire of the JDP Police Jury talks to create a parish website. All conversations led to the support of their efforts and how we may be able to aid. Further discussions will be held on this item. Also discussed was the added grant opportunity for the ETE (Economic Technology Enterprise) Center to be set up in Jennings.

Motion to Adjourn: A motion was made by Beau Hearod and seconded by Tony Hulsey and passed unanimously to adjourn.
