 Fontenot from the shopkeep account, used for merchandise at the Gator Chateau, and make
 either Creed Romano or Linda LeBlanc responsible for all financial or management matters,
 passed unanimously.
- A motion was made by Austin Bertrand and seconded by Ronnie Petree to allow Kyler Royer to
 continue as a second-year student at STS Marketing College in June and allow Jamie Lee to begin
 her education at STS Marketing College as well, passed unanimously.
- Austin Bertrand stated that Jeff Davis Parish in 2022 had over 82,000 acres of rice, which is the most we've had since 1973.
- **Buffine Crochet** stated that at the Hampton Inn in the year 2022, they received one of their highest number of guests passing through Jeff Davis Parish. The guest's biggest complaint is the lack of entertainment in the immediate area.

Kyler Royer, TOD:

- Kyler Royer reported the following:
- The 3rd annual SwampSTOL will be held from March 16th 18th. The Bernie Allan band will be playing for all participants and visitors. There are around 200 airplanes registered to attend this event. This is quickly becoming one of the largest STOL events in the country.
- Mardi Gras has officially kicked off in our parish. The City of Welsh held its first children's Mardi Gras run to great success, with over 90 participants. The City of Welsh also held its adult Mardi Gras event, with 36 floats and abundant horses. The City of Lake Arthur held their Mardi Gras festivities with over 50 floats. Elton held their children's Mardi Gras run with 29 participants. The City of Jennings and the Town of Elton will be holding their Mardi Gras events on February 18th.
- Crawfish farm tours will begin in March and run through May on every Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. We have already had multiple schools register, our largest has over 100 students and 100 parents.
- Marketing report from Jamie Lee: Mainly Marathon series will be held at the I-10 Park on March 21st. The SWLA Acoustic Cajun Music Jam will also continue every other Saturday at the Visitor
